1 Purpose

To ensure that prohibited hazardous substances are not purchased and delivered onboard.

2 Responsibilities

Carnival Corporation Global Sourcing and Operating Lines' Sourcing/Purchasing Departments are responsible to ensure compliance with this policy.

3 Requirements

All newly purchased materials (structural, machinery, electrical installations and equipment covered under the current SOLAS convention) must be free from any type of asbestos product.

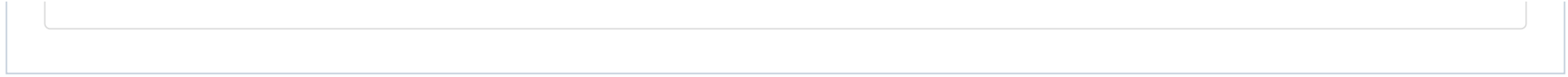
This policy must be posted in sourcing/purchasing department procedures and communicated to pertinent vendors.

5 Definitions

Asbestos: Naturally occurring mineral that once was lauded for its versatility, recognized for its heat resistance, tensile strength and insulating properties. Was commonly used in the past for fire-proof clothing, thermal insulation and brake linings. Prolonged inhalation of asbestos fibers can cause serious and fatal illnesses including lung cancer, mesothelioma, and asbestosis (a type of pneumoconiosis).
